Rocky Mount Volunteer Fire Department answered 22 calls for the month of December 2009. Eighteen (11) of the calls were outside the Town Limits and thirteen (11) were inside.

The Department logged 163 man hours for the month and there were no injuries during the month.

The Department drove a total of 1,926 miles and used 125 gallons of gasoline and 58 gallons of diesel.

The call types were as follows:

Utility 1 received damage to the right side when it side swiped a private vehicle while parking at a structure fire on Altice Mill Road. The private vehicle received light damage to the mirror and bumper. Singer Associates Fire Equipment is preparing an estimate on the Utility. Heavy snow contributed to the incident, shoulder parking was very limited.

We have not noticed any water leakage on the Fire Department side since the exterior repairs and brick sealing has been completed.

Repairs to overhead door #3 remote control at the North Main station have been completed.
