The Department is currently consulting several Fire Apparatus Manufacturers and in the final stages of assembling specifications for a new pumper. The specs will be put to bid within 45 days. This will meet guidelines of the FEMA grant received by the Department.

Fund raising efforts by the Department and the Departments Auxiliary for the Owen Lewis family has exceeded \$20,000.00. A final check will be present to his widow soon.

With the last heavy rain the station on North Main has developed a roof leak near the apparatus bay bathroom. The leak is minimum at present and appears to be around a vent pipe.
