The RMPD met with Ridge Schyler, aide to Congressman Perriello, in regards to monies available for law enforcement.

The RMPD met with Brett Reistad Law Enforcement Coordinator for ROCIC (Regional Organized Crime Information Center). The RMPD signed agreement with ROCIC for the sharing of information, equipment and surveillance products, as well as adding members to their gang and drug intel sites.

Throughout June, several items are of note. The department participated and/or assisted in the annual "DARE Day", the Special Olympics Torch Run, the FCHS graduation ceremony, the "Fun Festival", the "Craft Show" event, as well as the American Cancer Society's Relay for Life. In addition to these community events, the police department underwent a transition as I accepted and began work as the Interim Chief of the department while the lengthy process of hiring a permanent Chief of Police is conducted.

The department was able to increase business/residence checks throughout the month. While performing the business checks, officers where able to locate three businesses unsecured. The department had a slight reduction in residential foot patrols due to the work being done on the neighborhood intervention program, which put officers into residential areas for longer time periods.
