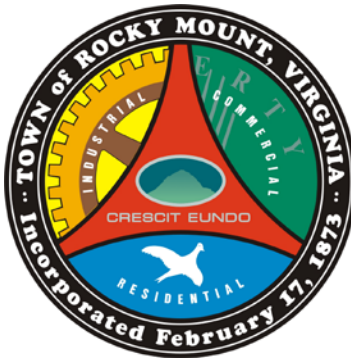

Luanne Wray, Pell Avenue

The Applicant, LJMT 515 Weaver Street LLC (Empire Foods) is requesting a Special Exception/Use Permit to operate a business to consumer outlet, selling finished baked goods at their manufacturing property located at 515 WEAVER STREET, ROCKY MOUNT, VA, 24151, Franklin County Tax Map and Parcel Number 2030000101A. The property is zoned M2 (Industrial, General District)

Town Planner Jessica Heckman presented the staff report. Mrs. Dudley from Empire Foods came forward and was available to answer questions. Member Ina Clements asked what items would be sold. Chairman Janet Stockton asked how they would advertise, Mrs. Dudley stated it would be on social media and by word of mouth. Member Bud Blanchard asked if the special exception would end with the current business. Jessica Heckman stated that staff recommendation was the application be approved with the condition that the special use permit is only valid so long as the current use continues.

Hearing no further comments from the board Madame Chair Janet Stockton asked for a motion.

(Industrial, General District) with the recommendation from staff that the special use permit is only valid so long as the food production plant remains in operation.
